OVERVIEW

The Artists' Group of Charlestown, Inc. (AGC) was founded in 1996 by a group of artists who recognized the need to support and encourage the development of the visual arts in Charlestown. Since 2002, the AGC has occupied and run the StoveFactory Studios and Gallery. The AGC is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization supported by its members, donors, and grants funding. Our mission is to showcase artists' work and to promote high quality cultural programming for the local community. We are run by a volunteer Board of Directors. We also form subcommittees for special tasks and activities. The AGC is 100% volunteer-driven.

OUR LOCATION

Located at 523 Medford Street in Charlestown, the **StoveFactory Studios and Gallery** are considered the home of the AGC, comprised of 24 studios and a 950 sq. foot gallery space. The **StoveFactory Gallery** allows us to hold and host shows, events, and activities within a creative space. The exhibits and programs sponsored by the AGC are open to the public and free of charge. The **StoveFactory Studios** are rented as private workspaces by individual artists and artisans of diverse disciplines and media, and we invite the public for Open Studios tours annually. In addition to our brick-and-mortar presence, the AGC has an online presence through our website and social media platforms to reflect and promote our current offerings.

AGC MEMBERSHIP

Members range from art students, to part-time artists, to emerging artists, to professional established artists. Artists and artisans of various media are all welcome and eligible to apply for membership, including but not limited to traditional studio fine arts (painting, sculpture), other 2-D fine art (photography, printmaking), media arts (animation, projection, etc.), and artisanry (jewelry, ceramics, wood, metal, etc.). There is no juried review process at this time; all those who are dedicated to creating, showing, selling, and otherwise sharing their artwork and contributing to the mission of the AGC are welcome. Artist Members do not have to be Charlestown residents.

ADVANTAGES OF ARTIST MEMBERSHIP INCLUDE:

- Listing your name and artwork on our AGC website's member webpage. This helps to both market your work and to show your involvement when you apply for grants, residencies, fellowships, teaching positions, etc.
- Periodic e-newsletters
- Promotion of your work through AGC social media accounts
- Proposal for a solo show in the StoveFactory Gallery once every two years
- Proposal to curate a group show once every two years
- Reduced fee for Open Studios events (for tenants in StoveFactory Studios)
- Reduced fee to submit artwork in non-juried and juried group shows in the StoveFactory Gallery
- Members may spearhead new ideas to add value to the community (i.e., small group critiques, workshops, etc.)

MEMBERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Join a subcommittee as a volunteer (Gallery, Fundraising, Membership, Communications, etc.)
- Attend the Annual Members' Meeting of the AGC each fall

ANNUAL DUES

Membership to the Artists Group of Charlestown is annual. Renewal cycles begin each fall. Annual dues for Artist Members are \$100 for individuals; \$25 for college students 18 and over with a valid student ID. Annual dues are non-refundable.

HOW WE RUN

AGC Members are part of the Board of Directors and/or choose subcommittees to serve with. The Board of Directors, elected by AGC Members, serves a two-year term without compensation. The Board of Directors is responsible for governance and manages the business and organizational affairs of the AGC. The Board can include members of the community as well as donors/supporters.
